I thought I would share the Nine Days of Prayer booklet that came with the Connexion Magazine and use it as a weekly rather than daily devotional. I hope you find it helpful. Thea.

Week 1:

Luke 8: 18 Consider carefully how you listen.

Pray:

Listening God, open my ears today to the world, to the stranger, to myself.

Pause:

Sit quietly, breathe deeply, and let the day greet you kindly.

Reflect:

This passage may feel harsh, a reprimand, a challenge. Jesus even seems to be rejecting his own family. But he also says that those who hear God's word and put it into practice will be his family. How will we be open to hear God's challenge in our lives today? Who have we been ignoring? Is there something that is nagging us or someone we need to attend to differently? How can we bring our faith into the light? How can we hear God's word and put it into practice?

Listen:

Listen for a while to what God may be saying to you today. How can we be aware of being held in deep attentiveness when God seems to be silent.?

Pray:

Listening God,
 light up the world
 through us today.
 Help us to hear your word
 and put it into practice.
